

SUMMARY OF OLIVER TWIST

 OLIVER IS BORN IN A WORKHOUSE AND LATER SOLD TO AN UNDERTAKER. HE ESCAPES TO LONDON, WHERE HE MEETS THE ARTFUL DODGER AND JOINS A GANG OF THIEVES. THROUGH VARIOUS TWISTS OF FATE, OLIVER EVENTUALLY FINDS HIS TRUE FAMILY AND A BETTER LIFE.
