- When we arrived the host family gave us their number, wifi password and house keys. They made us breakfast and dinner every day. They showed us the neighborhood so we could find our way around.



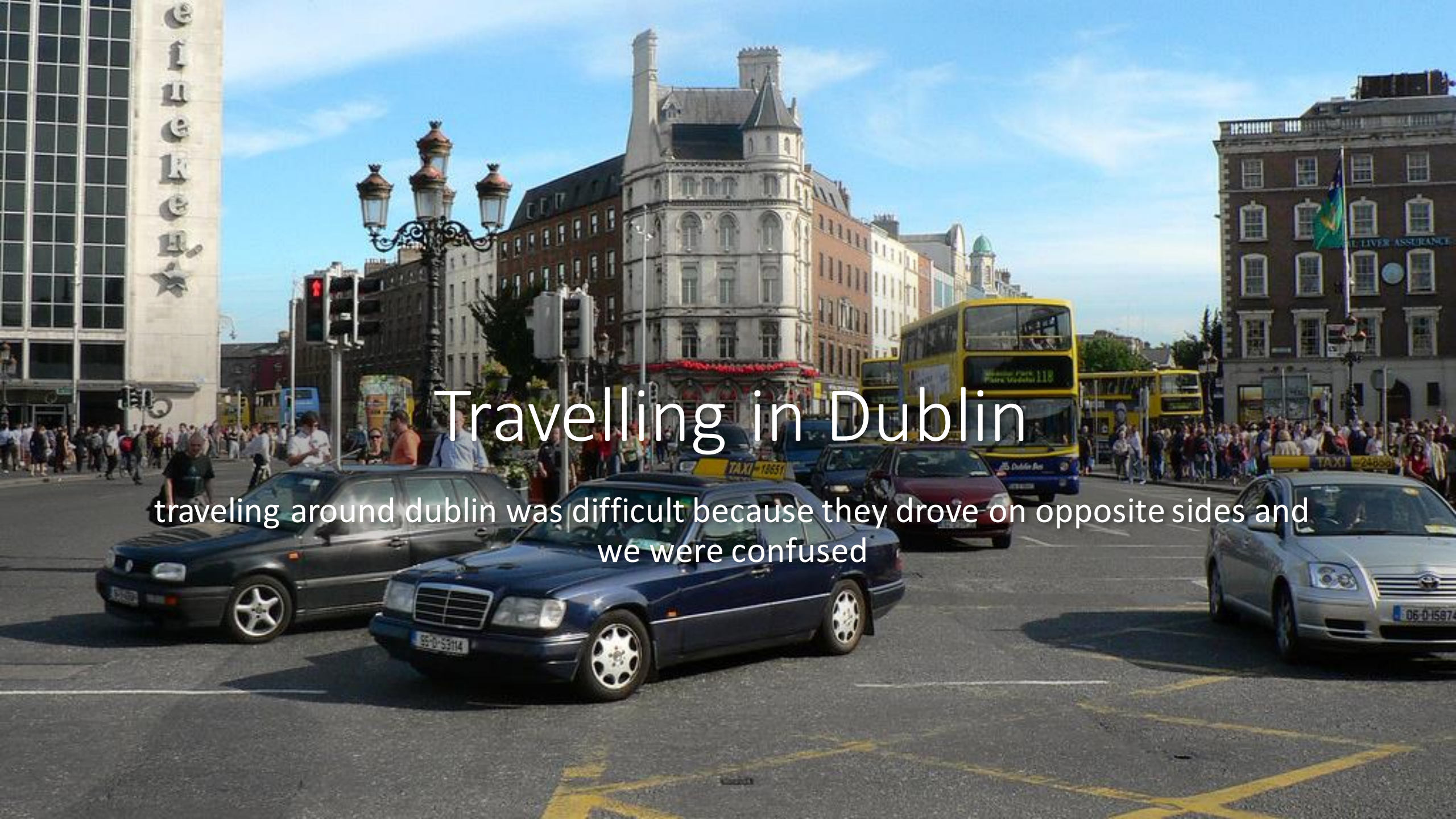


Travelling in Dublin

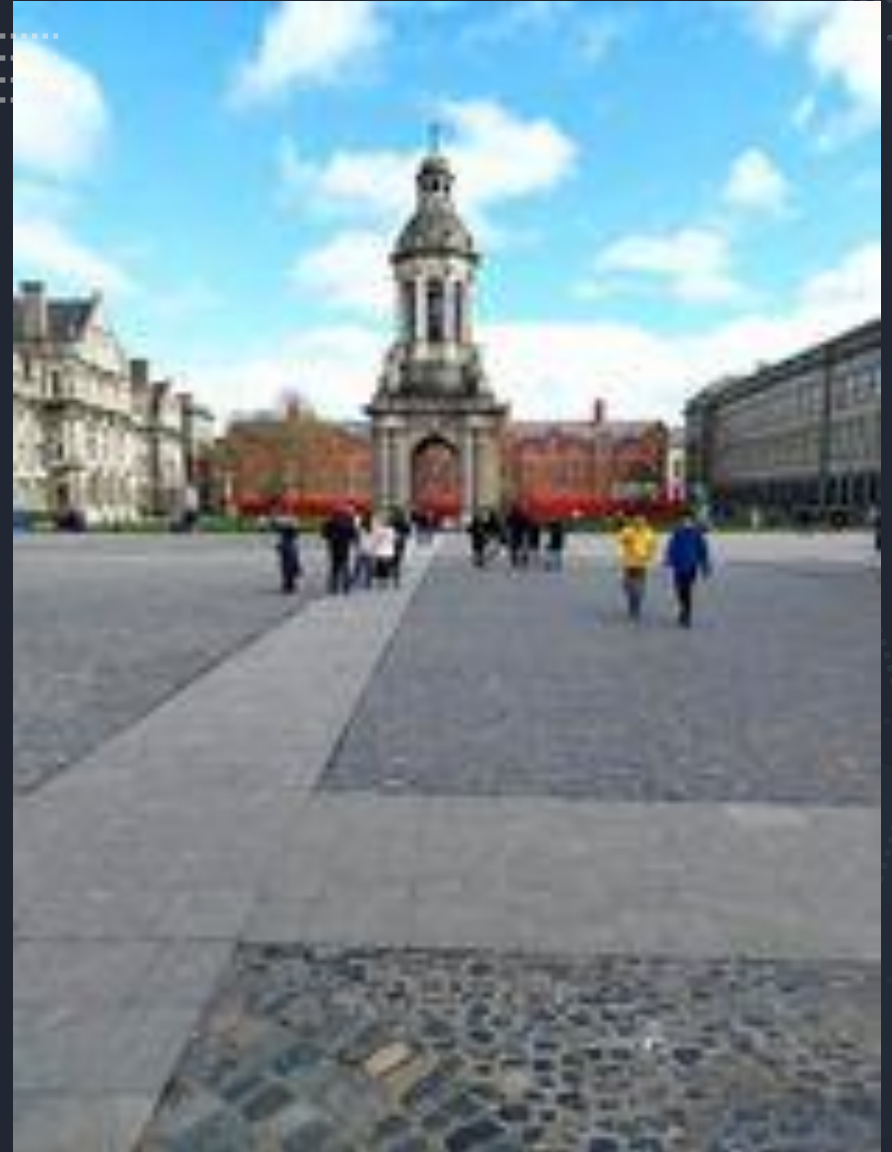
